Presentation of the organisation:

A Montreal-based cultural organization, Le Moulin à vent Productions offers participatory and inclusive activities with a circus, hebertism(*), traditional games and sports aimed at a wide audience.

As a member of En Piste, the Réseau des Arts de Rue du Québec, the Conseil Québécois du Patrimoine Vivant and listed in the Répertoire Culture-Éducation, the organization offers its entertainment services to events (attractions, parties, festivals) and the recreational sector (camps, schools, community centres) where it is recognized for the originality of its concepts.

This summer, Le Moulin à vent Productions is innovating once again with a pilot project, La Grande Aventure dans ton Parc (in Pointe-aux-Trembles), which aims to get people of all ages and conditions moving on its new Fun Hebertism Course.

In July/August, Le Moulin à Vent's artists and animators will implement several very active and inclusive outdoor activity programs in the East End of Montreal to share the taste of movement and the pleasure of moving through hebertism, circus and play. The team will also make weekly visits to municipal day camps in the regions bordering the greater Montreal area to get children moving.

Job description (tasks and responsibilities):

The animator implements the activity programmes developed by Le Moulin à vent Productions with a variety of audiences: children, teenagers, adults, seniors.

They may act as a specialist in :

- ✓ Multi-arts initiation programmes (e.g. circus, fairground arts, popular arts);
- ✓ Outdoor physical activity programs (e.g.: Fun Hebertism Course),
- ✓ Active discovery day programmes (e.g.: Ludiqu'Art Circus Course, Ephemeral Hebertism Circuit, Exploring the World's Games Workshop).

They: Participates in the development of the animation programmes and the contents they animate / Carry out quality, participative and engaging activities / Participates in the preparation & installation of the activity spaces and the logistics of each / Ensures the well-being and safety of the participants / Respects and implements the health and safety policy at work (in particular the sanitary measures) / Shares their know-how and knowledge with the team (co-training) / Demonstrates their talents and shares their passion in order to encourage the participation of all.

Qualifications:

Must be between 18 and 30 years of age
Legally entitled to work in Canada.

Studies in one of the following fields: circus, theatre, physical education and health teaching, management techniques and intervention in recreation, recreation-culture and tourism, cultural action, intervention in physical activity or related fields.

Have experience in animation (min. 2 years in day camp, summer camp, municipal recreation department...) and physical skills acquired through the practice of an art, a sport, outdoor activities in order to transmit a taste for movement.

Must be able to travel independently (vehicle, bicycle, public transport, etc.) to the workplace: St-Jean-Baptiste Park in Pointe-Aux-Trembles.

Training offered:

- ✓ Training with senior artists and game masters to develop the skills to facilitate these activity programmes with a variety of audiences (youth, families, seniors, girls/women, cultural communities, disabled);
- ✓ Workplace First Aid training.
